<i>Colour</i>	<i>Pale yellow and green.</i>
<i>Nose</i>	<i>Vibrant notes of rose petal and candy floss, nougat and talc.</i>
<i>Palate</i>	<i>Richly textured and mouth filling, delivering soft rose water and nougat flavours finishing dry.</i>
<i>Viticulture</i>	<i>100% of the fruit for this wine was selected from our Waipara Valley vineyard The Mound.</i>
<i>Maturation</i>	<i>The fruit was matured in 100% Stainless steel for 5 months until it evolved its aromatic lift.</i>
<i>Peak drinking</i>	<i>2009 - 2011</i>
