<i>Palate</i>	<i>Medium weight with a lively mineral acidity. Flavours of apple and lime.</i>
<i>Viticulture</i>	<i>100% of the fruit for this wine was selected from our Waipara valley vineyard The Mound.</i>
<i>Maturation</i>	<i>100% Stainless steel was used to retain the fresh fruit characters of this wine.</i>
